On Monday, January 29<sup>th</sup>, the two East corners of Dairy Ashford are to be completed and lane changes implemented. Presumably a return to normalcy for the time being. The two West corners of Dairy Ashford have been delayed because private utilities have not yet been relocated.

Intersection work will shift back to Kirkwood and Memorial starting with the Northeast corner (followed by Northwest, Southwest and Southeast corners). Each corner will take about two months. Expect major lane changes over the next eight months.

### Lawn & Garden Checklist

- Apply **NitroPhos Barricade** or **Bonide Weed Beater Complete Preemergent Granules** to control both broadleaf and grassy weeds!
- Purchase Caladium Bulbs
- Plant or transplant Trees and Shrubs
- Spray dandelions (another broadleaf weed) with **Bonide Weed Beater Southern**

### Organic Checklist

- **Corn Gluten Meal** has been known to deter weed seeds from germinating!
- Plant Trees and Shrubs using **Calloway's Tree & Shrub Planting Mix**
- Apply **Soil Mender Lava Sand** to beds
- Prune Peach and Plum Trees

## Gardens, Lawns and Landscape – Post Harvey

*Robert "Skip" Richter, Director, Harris County Extension Agent – Horticulture, gave an interesting and valuable talk about Harvey landscape and tree matters at this month's Memorial Super Neighborhood meeting. Here are a few highlights (Courtesy of Joe Smith):*

Regarding grass, all front yards that flooded will likely need aeration with plugs removed and a top dressing of rich compost materials. Water it in. Only add sod if this does not work. Sod on top of hard soil will not work that well if soil is not open to water and air. In Summer (for grass in full sun), grass should be kept mowed to 2.5 inches (not shorter) and all clippings should be left on the lawn to decompose. These clippings are the best source of fertilizer. Grass in shade or under trees needs to be cut longer than 2.5 inches. Most lawns are over-watered. They need only .5 to 1 inch of water every week if the grass gets 6+ hours of sun per day. Fertilizer should be in the ration of 3-1-2 and is applied in the Spring only after the lawn has been cut twice during the regular growing season. Cutting to remove dead grass and leaves or weeds does not count.

Regarding trees, they may have suffered from too much water – root rot. It may take 3-5 years for problems to show. Hire a certified arborist to check your trees if you have any concern about their health. Visit the following website to locate an arborist:

Do not worry about brown water contamination of soil. This is really a non-issue as nature breaks down the bad stuff in 3 months or less.


Join us for some good food and great company as we laissez les bons temps rouler!

## Queensbury Theatre Presents Unlock'd


