Registration for the Westchester Dolphins is now available online at the following link: <https://westchesterdolphins.swimtopia.com/register>. You must register online, but you can pay online or by check. Here are the swim team fees. Each swimmer's registration includes a team T-shirt.

- First Swimmer = \$160
- Second Swimmer = \$100
- Third Swimmer = \$70
- Each Additional Swimmer = \$50

Note: A \$15 discount will be applied to the first swimmer if registered by Saturday, April 13. Fees for swimmers aged 15-18 will be \$50 regardless of how many swimmers are in the family.

Remember, Westchester, Nottingham Forest VIII and Westchester Villas residents must also pay annual fees to the Westchester Pool in order to participate in the swim team. Lawn & Garden Checklist

- Plant Spring Bulbs
- Plant Caladium Bulbs & Elephant Ear Bulbs after the 15th
- Feed Trees and Shrubs with **Calloway's Professional Tree & Shrub Food**
- Watch for fungus as brown patch; apply **Bonide Infuse Spray or Granules** as needed

From the Yard of the Month Committee

We look forward to the beginning of another spring in our beautiful neighborhood with so many beautiful yards!

2019 Suggestions:

Our beautiful mature trees and shrubs are a great advantage to our neighborhood, but sometimes shrubs and other plants that were the right size when they were planted have gotten too large for their location and detract from the view of the house rather than enhance its appearance. Our recommendation is to look at your yard from the street. Are there shrubs or plants blocking the view of the house or the front door too much or that look out of place? Visualize the house without them. Would it look better? Sometimes there are shrubs, etc. that might need to be replaced with a smaller shrub, but other times there are plenty of other smaller plants and the appearance of the house would be improved if they were simply removed or trimmed back significantly. For special shrubs like azaleas that you don't want to lose, the best time to transplant them is in the fall (rather than now with the hot summer coming up before they get time to replenish their roots). But now, after the azaleas finish blooming, is the perfect time to trim them back before they set their buds for next year. We wish you pleasure in all your gardening endeavors this year!

Saturday April 20 9:30 am

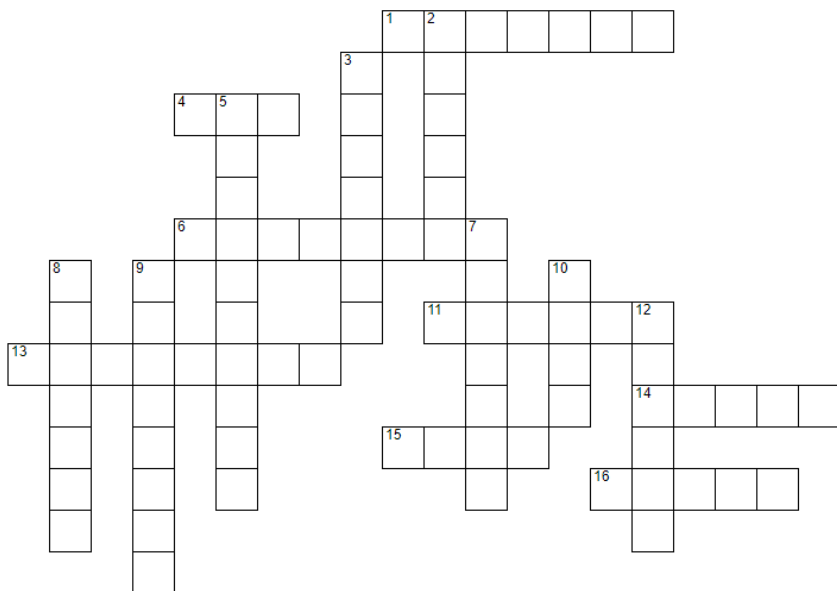
